8 to S.P. 576, L.D. 1717, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Cor-
9 rections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end be-
12 fore the emergency clause the following:

'PART C

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §1368-C, sub-§1, as enacted by
15 PL 1987, c. 245, is amended to read:

16

1. Children 4 to 13 years of age. When a child
17 4 years of age or older, but less than ~~12~~ 13 years of
18 age, is a passenger in a motor vehicle, which is re-
19 quired by the United States Department of Transporta-
20 tion to be equipped with seat belts, the operator of
21 the motor vehicle shall have the child properly se-
22 cured in a seat belt or in a child safety seat that
23 meets the requirements set out in 49 Code of Federal
24 Regulations, Part 571.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sec-
26 tions to read consecutively.
