IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Construction Standards for Access for Handicapped Persons to Public Facilities.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2701, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 80, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

5. Standards of construction. "Standards of construction" means the most recent standards set forth by the American National Standards Institute in the publication "Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped," except as otherwise exempted or pro-

 Life Safety Code 101 or as amended by rule of the Director of Public Improvements.
- 4 Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2701, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 5 1981, c. 334, §4, is repealed.

6 Sec. 3. 25 MRSA §2702-A, sub-§1, as amended by 7 PL 1981, c. 698, §113, is repealed and the following 8 enacted in its place:

9 <u>1. Amendments to standards. Prior and subse-</u> quent to adopting any amendments to the standards, the director shall consult with physically handicapped people and their representatives and with persons regulated by this law and their representatives, to obtain their advice on the advisability, form and effect of any amendments to the standards.

16 Sec. 4. 25 MRSA §2702-A, sub-§2, as enacted by 17 PL 1981, c. 334, §6, is amended to read:

18 2. <u>Application</u>. All construction, remodeling and enlarging begun after January 1, 1982 1988, of buildings subject to this chapter shall comply with the 1981 standards of construction.

STATEMENT OF FACT

23 This new draft amends current law regarding construction standards for making facilities accessible 24 the physically handicapped to reflect newly pub-25 to 26 lished specifications and future revisions. This new 27 draft places the standards in the statute and autho-28 rizes the Director of Public Improvements to amend 29 those standards by rule. It also corrects the imple-30 mentation date.
