Resolve, Authorizing the Director of Public Improvements to Resolve an 2 Encroachment on State Property in 3 4 Hallowell.

6 Director of Public Improvements authorized to 7 sell. Resolved: That the Director of Public Im-8 provements is authorized to sell at appraised value to Gerard P. and Angela G. Bilodeau the following property:

Boundary Description - State of Maine to Bilodeau Pleasant Street Place, Hallowell, Maine 12

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the northeasterly side of Pleasant Street Place, so-

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called, in the City of Hallowell, Kennebec County, State of Maine, and being bounded and described as follows:

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3 4 Beginning on the northeasterly right-of-way line 5 said Pleasant Street Place at the westerly corner 6 of land of said Gerard P. and Angela G. Bilodeau, reference deed recorded in Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Book 2587, Page 160; thence N 26° 27' 58" 7 8 9 E along the northwesterly line of land of said Bilodeau a distance of 173.12 feet to a capped 10 3/4-inch iron rod set and other land of 11 State of Maine, reference deeds recorded in said Registry of 12 13 Deeds in Book 668, Page 205 and Book 50, Pages 364 and 365; thence S 31° 00' 14" W along land to be re-14 tained by said State of Maine, reference deed re-15 corded in said Registry of Deeds in Book 288, Page 16 17 308, a distance of 172.13 feet to a capped 3/4-inch iron rod set; thence S 57° 09' 43" E along land to be 18 retained by said State of Maine and along the north-19 20 easterly right-of-way line of said Pleasant Street Place a distance of 13.70 feet to the point of begin-21 22 ning, contained 1,179 square feet, more or less.

Being a portion of the premises described in a deed of Almira C. Dummer to the Maine Industrial School for Girls, dated March 25, 1874, recorded in Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Book 288, Page 308.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve will remove a long standing encroachment of a state property line involving a small triangular piece of land on which there has been a portion of a private structure standing for many decades. This action will enable the private property owners to complete the sale of their property.

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
