HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1743,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of
Departments and Agencies of State Government under
the Maine Sunset Laws."

Amend the Bill in Part A, in section 173, in that
part designated "§3821-A." in the 3rd line from the
end (page 105, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "baord" and inserting in its place the
following: 'board'

Further amend the Bill in Part A, in section 212,
in that part designated "§13192." in subsection 4, in
the last line (page 143, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting
after the following: "estate" the following:
'brokerage'

Further amend the Bill in Part A, in section 215,
in subsection 2, in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 177,
lines 22 and 23 in L.D.) by inserting after the fol-
lowing: "transferred." the following: 'Members of the
Board of Examiners for the Examination of Applicants
for Admission to the Bar who have been appointed to
terms extending beyond the effective date of this Act
shall continue to serve on the board of bar examiners
created by the Supreme Judicial Court until their
successors are appointed.'

Further amend the Bill in Part A by inserting af-
ter section 215 the following:

'Sec. 216. Transition for boards and commissions.
Members of the Real Estate Commission and Maine Ath-
letic Commission who have been appointed to terms ex-
tending beyond the effective date of this Act shall
continue to serve in their appointed terms of office
until their successors are appointed.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 590, L.D. 1743

1 Members of the State Claims Board who have been
2 appointed to terms extending beyond the effective
3 date of this Act shall continue to serve on the State
4 Claims Board for their appointed terms until their
5 successors are appointed.'

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This amendment inserts transition provisions for
8 4 boards, corrects a typographical error and clari-
9 fies a provision in section 212 of the bill.
