HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1278, L.D. 1749,
Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Compliance Schedule for
Owners and Operators of Salt Storage Areas."

Amend the bill in subsection 1-A in the first
paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 2 in L.D.)
by inserting after the following: "subchapter." the
following: 'The department shall administer this
schedule according to the project priority list
adopted by the board pursuant to section 411 and the
provisions of this subsection.'

Further amend the bill in subsection 1-A by
striking out all of paragraphs A to D and inserting
in their place the following:

'A. Preliminary plans and engineers' estimates
shall be completed and submitted to the Depart-
ment of Transportation by the following dates:

(1) For Priority 1 and 2 projects - January
1989;

(2) For Priority 3 project - January 1990;

(3) For Priority 4 project - January 1991;
and

(4) For Priority 5 project - January 1992.

B. Arrangements for administration and financing
shall be completed within 12 months of the dates
established in paragraph A for each priority cat-
egory.

C. Detailed engineering and final plan formula-
tion shall be completed within 24 months of the

1 dates established in paragraph A for each priority
2 category.

3 D. Review of final plans with the Department of
4 Transportation shall be completed and construc-
5 tion commenced within 36 months of the dates es-
6 tablished in paragraph A for each priority cate-
7 gory. The Department of Transportation shall
8 consult with the department in reviewing final
9 plans.'

10 Further amend the bill in subsection 1-A in the
11 last paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 2,
12 lines 33 and 34 in L.D.) by striking out the under-
13 lined words "who is eligible for a state grant"

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this amendment is to make a ratio-
16 nal connection between the construction schedule for
17 salt storage buildings and the priority list already
18 established by the Department of Environmental Pro-
19 tection under its existing authority and also to de-
20 delete a redundant phrase in the new draft.
