## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA \$1760, sub-\$41, as amended by PL 1981, c. 705, Pt. K, is further amended to read:

41. Certain instrumentalities of interstate or foreign commerce. The sale or lease of a vehicle, or the sale of railroad rolling stock, aircraft or watercraft which is placed in use by the purchaser or lessee as an instrumentality of interstate or foreign commerce within 30 days after that sale or lease and which is used by the purchaser or lessee not less than 80% of the time for the next 2 years as an instrumentality of interstate or foreign commerce. 1 State Tax Assessor may for good cause extend for not more than 30 days the time for placing the instrumen-tality in use in interstate or foreign commerce. For 2 3 4 purposes of this subsection, property is "placed in use as an instrumentality of interstate or foreign commerce" by its carrying of, or providing the motive 5 6 7 power for the carrying of, a bona fide payload in in-8 terstate or foreign commerce, or by being dispatched 9 to a specific location at which it will be loaded 10 with, or will be used as motive power arrival upon 1.1 for the carrying of, a payload in interstate or foreign commerce. For purposes of this subsection, "bona 12 payload" means a cargo of persons or property 13 fide 14 transported by a contract or common carrier for com-15 pensation which exceeds the direct cost of carrying that cargo or pursuant to a legal obligation to 16 pro-17 vide service as a public utility or a cargo of property transported in the reasonable conduct 18 of the 19 purchaser's own nontransportation business in inter-20 state commerce.
