AN ACT to Protect the State's Freshwater  
Great Ponds and Rivers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

30 MRSA §3223-B is enacted to read:

§3223-B. Transfers of shoreland property

Any person transferring property on which a sub-  
surface waste water disposal system is located within  
a shoreland area, as defined in Title 38, section  
435, shall provide the transferee with a sworn state-  
ment at the time of transfer certifying with any nec-  
essary written documentation that:
