Amend the bill in the 6th paragraph after the ti-
tle by striking out subsection 1 and inserting in its
place the following:

'1. Legislators. One Senator appointed by the
President of the Senate and 2 members of the House of
Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the
House. At least one of the Legislators shall be a
member of the Joint Standing Committee on Education;'

Further amend the bill in the 6th paragraph in
subsection 4 (Page 2, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting
after the following: "to be appointed" the follow-
ing: 'by the President of the Senate from a list of
nominees submitted'

'5. Financial aid officer. Two members who are
financial aid administrators in a private
post-secondary institution, one of which is a
business-oriented institution; 2 members who are fi-
nancial aid administrators at a campus of the Univer-
sity of Maine System; one member who is a financial
aid administrator at the Maine Maritime Academy; and
one member who is a financial aid administrator at a
vocational-technical institute, 3 of whom are to be
appointed by the President of the Senate and 3 of
whom are to be appointed by the Speaker of the House
from a list of nominees submitted by the Maine Asso-
ciation of Financial Aid Directors.
