AN ACT to Authorize Hospitals to Use Magnetic Resonance Imaging Devices Located in Private Physicians' Facilities.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a certificate of need waiver for use of existing magnetic resonance imaging machines by inpatients is necessary immediately for the health and safety of patients; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

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the Constitution of Maine and require the following 1 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 2 3 therefore, 4 it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 Be 6 follows: 7 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §304-A, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 8 1981, c. 705, Pt. Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This new draft replaces the original bill and 6 provides a one-year grace period on the certificate of need requirement for use by inpatients of any ex-7 isting magnetic resonance imaging machines which were acquired on or before June 1, 1987. The grace period 8 9 is repealed July 1, 1988. It is anticipated that a 10 11 more permanent resolution will be enacted by that 12 time.

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
