AN ACT to Alter the Fee on the Registration
of Underground Tanks.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 38 MRSA §563, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
7 496. Pt. A, §14, is repealed and the following en-
8 acted in its place:

9 4. Registration fees. The owner or operator of
10 an underground oil storage facility used in the mar-
11 keting and distribution of oil shall pay an initial
12 registration fee to the department of \$25 and an an-
13 nual fee of \$12.50 thereafter for each tank with a
14 capacity less than or equal to 6,000 gallons and an
15 initial registration fee to the department of \$50 and

1 an annual fee of \$25 thereafter for each tank with a
2 capacity in excess of 6,000 gallons located at the
3 facility. The initial registration fee payment shall
4 accompany the initial registration form. Annual pay-
5 ments thereafter shall be paid on or before January
6 1st of each calendar year.

7 FISCAL NOTE

8 The Office of Fiscal and Program Review has de-
9 termined that enactment of this bill will result in a
10 loss of Dedicated Revenue to the Department of Envi-
11 ronmental Protection's Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund
12 of \$83,025 annually.

13 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This new draft correctly implements the intent of
15 the original bill that the fee for reregistration of
16 underground storage tanks be 1/2 of the original reg-
17 istration fee.
