## SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1787

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13	This amendment would prohibit harassment of any person which is intended to cause fear or apprehension or otherwise infringe on the lawful enjoyment of that person's constitutional and legal rights. References in the original bill which proscribed acts of harassment motivated by race, color, sex, ethnic background, nationality, country of origin, religious belief, age, sexual orientation or disability are deleted. The amendment also expands the incident report requirements of the State Bureau of Investigation. The amendment also deletes references to Indian law enforcement agencies. This amendment also clarifies that a victim of harassment may be of any age. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
