18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	This new draft requires the Maine Health Care Finance Commission to recognize a hospital's volume increases as they actually occurred in the first and 2nd payment years, instead of after a 2-year wait. It requires the commission to recognize the costs which certain hospitals have already experienced because of past volume increases in the first and 2nd years.
