HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 608, L.D. 1798,
Bill, "AN ACT to Require Maintenance of Financial Responsibility by All Motorists."

10 Amend the Bill by inserting after section 2 the 11 following:

12 'Sec. 3. 29 MRSA §102, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 13 1985, c. 429, §8, is amended to read:

14 vehicle may be operated, or remain upon any No 15 way, unless the same is registered and equipped in accordance with this Title, excepting that any offi-cer of the State Police, any sheriff or full-time 16 17 18 deputy sheriff or any full-time municipal police officer may, when in his opinion the same is necessary 19 20 and not detrimental to the public safety, grant a 21 permit in writing for an unregistered motor vehicle 22 to be towed either by a regular service wrecker or by 23 the use of a towbar. Further, any officer of the 24 State Police, any sheriff or full-time deputy sherany full-time municipal police officer and cer-25 iff, 26 tain employees of the Motor Vehicle Division so designated by the Secretary of State shall issue a per-27 mit to allow the operation of an unregistered 28 motor vehicle only to the owner's residence or to an office of the Motor Vehicle Division for the sole purpose of 29 30 31 renewing the registration of that vehicle by the same 32 as indicated on the expired registration cerowner 33 tificate. The permit shall be issued only when the 34 previous registration on the vehicle has expired 35 within 30 days. The permit shall not remain valid for 36 more than 3 consecutive days including the date of issuance. Application for such registration may be 37 made by mail or otherwise to the Secretary of State upon blanks prepared under his authority. The appli-cation shall be signed by the owner and shall contain 38 39 40

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1 such particulars as may be required by the Secretary 2 of State, including the name, residence and address 3 of the owner, evidence of motor vehicle liability insurance or financial responsibility, current mileage, 4 5 with a brief description of the vehicle, the name of 6 its maker, vehicle identification number, the amount 7 of motive power, stated in figures of horsepower, the type of motor fuel if other than gasoline as defined in Title 36, section 2902, under the phrase "internal combustion engine fuel" and the actual gross weight 8 9 10 11 of the vehicle if intended for commercial use.

12 Further amend the Bill in section 3 in that part 13 designated "<u>\$780.</u>" by inserting after subsection 5 14 the following:

15 Impoundment. Whenever a motor vehicle '6. is being operated by a person not having upon his person or in the vehicle the evidence of insurance or finan-cial responsibility required under subsection 2, the 16 17 18 19 law enforcement officer, or any other law enforcement 20 officer, may impound that vehicle and hold it until that vehicle is claimed and taken by the registered 21 22 owner of the vehicle, who shall be notified of the impounding, or until the registered owner verifies 23 the authority of the operator to so operate.' 24

Further amend the Bill in section 3 in that part designated "<u>§780.</u>" in section 780 by renumbering subsections 6 to 8 to be subsections 7 to 9.

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HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 608, L.D. 1798

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1 STATEMENT OF FACT 2 This amendment requires a person to produce evi-3 dence of insurance or financial responsibility before 4 a person may register a vehicle. The amendment also 5 provides the additional penalty of impoundment for 6 persons who do not comply with the provisions of the bill.
