Site location. The free standing maxi-22 mum security prison to be constructed in Warren, 23 Maine, pursuant to this Act, may not be located be-24 tween the St. George River and Route 97. The term 25 "prison" means buildings and the secured compound surrounding prison buildings, but it does not include 26 27 service systems and utilities. 28 Sec. 6. Site Selection Advisory Committee. 29 Site Selection Advisory Committee shall be formed to 30 review site plans and the construction of the prison 31 at Warren and it shall advise the Commissioner of 32 Corrections. The committee shall be comprised of 2 citizens of the Town of Warren, recommended by the selectmen and appointed by the Governor and, one Senator appointed by the President of the Senate, who 33 34 35 36 shall come from the geographic area surrounding the

Warren site and 2 Representatives, appointed by the

3 4 5 6	Each person required to make an appointment or appointments pursuant to this Act shall make the appointment by July 31, 1987, and shall notify the Commissioner of Corrections.
7 8 9 10 11 12	When the appointment of all commission members is completed, the Commissioner of Corrections shall call the advisory committee together for its first meeting, no later than August 15, 1987. The members of the Site Selection Advisory Committee shall elect a chairman from among its membership at its first meeting.
.5 .6 .7	Sec. 7. Compensation. The members of the advisory committee shall receive reimbursement, for expenses only, upon application to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council.
.8 .9 ?0	Sec. 8. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

11 12 13	3. It establishes a Site Selection Advisory Committee which shall review site plans and the construction of the prison at Warren; and
14 15	4. It authorizes reimbursement of expenses only for members of the Site Selection Advisory Committee.
