HOUSE AMENDMENT "*B*" to S.P. 610, L.D. 1800,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Allocate the Proceeds of the Sale of  
General Fund Bonds for Construction and Renovation of  
Correctional Facilities."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking  
out all of the 13th to 23rd lines (page 3, lines 11  
to 21 in L.D.) and insert in their place the follow-  
ing:

'Construction of free-standing,  
separate maximum security  
prison in Warren, Maine. \$11,000,000'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end  
before the emergency clause the following:

**Sec. 5. Site location.** The free standing maxi-  
mum security prison to be constructed in Warren,  
Maine, pursuant to this Act, may not be located be-  
tween the St. George River and Route 97. The term  
"prison" means buildings and the secured compound  
surrounding prison buildings, but it does not include  
service systems and utilities.

**Sec. 6. Site Selection Advisory Committee.** A  
Site Selection Advisory Committee shall be formed to  
review site plans and the construction of the prison  
at Warren and it shall advise the Commissioner of  
Corrections. The committee shall be comprised of 2  
citizens of the Town of Warren, recommended by the  
selectmen and appointed by the Governor and, one Sen-  
ator appointed by the President of the Senate, who  
shall come from the geographic area surrounding the  
Warren site and 2 Representatives, appointed by the

1 Speaker of the House, who shall also come from the  
2 geographic area.

3 Each person required to make an appointment or  
4 appointments pursuant to this Act shall make the ap-  
5 pointment by July 31, 1987, and shall notify the Com-  
6 missioner of Corrections.

7 When the appointment of all commission members is  
8 completed, the Commissioner of Corrections shall call  
9 the advisory committee together for its first meet-  
10 ing, no later than August 15, 1987. The members of  
11 the Site Selection Advisory Committee shall elect a  
12 chairman from among its membership at its first meet-  
13 ing.

14 **Sec. 7. Compensation.** The members of the advis-  
15 ory committee shall receive reimbursement, for ex-  
16 penses only, upon application to the Executive Direc-  
17 tor of the Legislative Council.

18 **Sec. 8. Appropriation.** The following funds are  
19 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the  
20 purposes of this Act.
