5 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
6 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
7 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
8 and

9 Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 13-A,
10 section 1301, subsection 3 and Title 13-B, section
11 1301, subsection 4, require that annual and biennial
12 reports be filed by June 1st; and

13 Whereas, corporations frequently have need of
14 certificates of good standing in the course of con-

ducting their businesses and obtaining suitable financing; and

Whereas, it has become necessary to extend the date to September 1st for the sole purpose of issuing certificates of good standing in 1987; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Filing date for corporation reports. Resolved: That notwithstanding the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 13-A, section 1301, subsection 3, and Title 13-B, section 1301, subsection 4, the date for filing annual or biennial corporation reports shall be considered to be September 1st for the sole purpose of issuing certificates of good standing in 1987 only.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Due to a staff reduction, a temporary 3 month extension for issuing certificates of good standing required under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 13-A and 13-B, section 1301 has become necessary.

It is not the intention of this resolve to waive any penalties for failure to file reports by June 1st as required by Title 13-A, section 1301 and by Title 13-B, section 1301.

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
