STATEMENT OF FACT

At present, individuals who receive a disability retirement benefit based on the actuarial equivalent 2 3 4 of their contributions receive a cost-of-living increase from both the Maine State Retirement System 5 and from Social Security or workers' compensation. 6 7 This amendment would allow these individuals to con-8 tinue to receive their adjustments. This amendment also corrects the date of application of a correction 9 in the retirement laws. 10
