The total cost to the General Fund will be \$187,072 and \$263,148 in fiscal year 1987-88 and 1988-89, respectively. These General Fund amounts include direct appropriation to Teacher Retirement of \$133,510 and \$187,805, respectively. Other costs will include additional contributions from the various funds of:

This new draft allows recipients to receive their cost-of-living increases from workers' compensation and social security. Under the present interpretation of the law these cost-of-living increases are offset against the Maine State Retirement System pension. Under present law, cost-of-living increases earned on Maine State Retirement benefits are not offset.
