This bill will result in an estimated 110 addi-  
tional offenders requiring time in a correctional fa-  
cility. This will result in placements at facilities  
other than State owned due to the limited number of  
cells available. The cost to house prisoners at  
county jails is about \$1,000 per month, therefore,  
the appropriation is required. Due to the estimated  
effective date of the bill, only 50% of the required  
funding is provided in fiscal year 1987-88.'
