SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1333, L.D. 1823,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Aggravated Trafficking or
Furnishing Scheduled Drugs under the Maine Criminal
Code."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the statement
of fact the following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.

Fiscal Note

This bill will result in some additional offend-
ers spending time in a correctional facility, al-
though not as many as with mandatory sentencing. The
appropriation will enable the department to house
about 50 prisoners annually at county-owned facili-
ties. Due to the estimated effective date of this
bill, only 50% of the required funding is provided in
fiscal year 1987-88.'
