**AN ACT to Expand Employment Opportunities
for Minors under the Age of 16 Years.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there are many minors under the age of
16 years who desire to work during the summer months;
and

Whereas, the encouragement of teenage employment
is a desirable goal and these persons should not be
discouraged from pursuing suitable work which does
not pose a danger of harm; and
