Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Tort Claims Act, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 14, chapter 741, Alton Dishon, of East Millinocket, be authorized to bring suit against the Maine State Retirement System for lost benefits and future benefits that may become due to him caused by alleged misrepresentation on the part of agents of the Maine State Retirement System which have caused Alton Dishon sub-

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes Alton Dishon, of East 24 Millinocket, to sue the Maine State Retirement System, but limits that recovery to a total of no more 25 than \$50,000. The \$50,000 limit is a total of damages paid by all sources, including any damages paid under 28 an insurance policy. If successful in his suit, Alton Dishon may be awarded up to a total of \$50,000.
