STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize Androscoggin County to Raise Up to \$8,900,000 to Renovate and Expand Jail Facilities for Androscoggin County.

6 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 7

Sec. 1. To raise money for construction and improvement of jail facilities for Androscoggin County. The county commissioners of the County of Androscoggin are authorized to raise and expend a sum not to exceed \$8,900,000 for renovation and expansion of the county jail facilities located in Auburn.

14 Sec. 2. Aid from other sources. The county com-15 missioners of the County of Androscoggin are autho-

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1 rized to borrow any portion of the sums herein autho-2 rized from or through any agency or department of the 3 State of Maine and of the Federal Government. The county commissioners are authorized to receive grants 4 5 money and other assistance from or through any of 6 agency or department of the State of Maine and of the 7 Federal Government for any of the purposes authorized 8 in this Act.

Sec. 3. Bonds. 9 To provide funds for the county 10 jail facilities, the treasurer of Androscoggin Coun-11 ty, with the approval of the county commissioners, 12 may borrow from time to time upon the full faith and 13 credit of the county such sums, not exceeding in the 14 aggregate \$8,900,000, as may be necessary and may is-15 sue bonds therefor which shall bear on their face the words "Androscoggin County Capital Improvement Bonds 16 Act of 1987." Each authorized issue shall be payable 17 18 in such annual installments, beginning not more than 19 2 years from the date thereof and not earlier than 20 the year 1989, as will extinguish each loan in not more than 20 years from its date. The bonds shall be 21 22 signed by the treasurer of the county and counter-23 signed by the majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell the securities at public or pri-24 25 vate sale upon such terms and conditions as the coun-26 commissioners may deem proper, but at not less ty 27 than par and accrued interest.

28 Sec. 4. Temporary notes. The county treasurer, 29 with the approval of the county commissioners, may 30 issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not 31 more than one year from their dates, in anticipation 32 of the issue of serial bonds under this Act and mav 33 renew the same, but the time within which such serial 34 bonds shall become due and payable shall not, by rea-35 son of such temporary notes, be extended beyond the 36 term fixed by this Act. Any notes issued in antici-37 pation of the serial bonds shall be paid from the proceeds of the bonds. 38

39 Sec. 5. Bonds authorized but not issued. Any 40 bonds authorized but not issued, or for which bond 41 anticipation notes have not been issued within 5 42 years of the ratification of this Act, shall be 43 deauthorized and may not be issued, provided that the 44 Legislature may, within 2 years after the expiration

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of that 5-year period, extend the period for issuing any remaining unissued bonds or bond anticipation notes for an additional amount of time not to exceed 5 years.

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Sec. 6. Referendum for ratification. This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of Androscoggin County. The dates of such submission shall be determined by the Androscoggin County Board of Commissioners but not later than 18 months after adjournment of the Legislature. The Androscoggin County commissioners are authorized to expend such funds as are necessary to implement the referendum.

13 The county commissioners shall cause the prepara-14 tion of the required ballots on which they shall 15 state the subject matter of this Act in the following 16 question:

17 "Shall the issuance of bonds be authorized in an amount not to exceed \$8,900,000 for renovation and expansion of jail facilities for Androscoggin County?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This Act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at the election; provided the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this Act equals or exceeds 30% of the total votes for all candidates for Governor cast in the next previous gubernatorial election in the county. If at any such first election, the total number of votes cast for or against acceptance of this Act is less than 30% of the total votes for all candidates for Governor cast in the county in the next previous gubernatorial election, the county commissioners may submit the question to voters not more than one other time within the time prescribed in this section.

The result of such elections shall be declared by the Androscoggin County Commissioners and due certificate filed with the Secretary of State.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to authorize the 3 Androscoggin County Commissioners to seek approval 4 from county voters to raise up to \$8,900,000 for con-5 struction and improvement of jail facilities for 6 Androscoggin County.

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
