Except as provided in subparagraph (1), li-censees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the 15 16 17 hours of 6 a.m. and 12 noon. 18 Hotel and Class A restaurants may sell (1)19 liquor on Sundays beginning at 10 a.m. in accordance with sections 1061 and 1063 re-20 21 spectively.' 22 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 23 84 the following: 24 'Sec. 85. 28-A MRSA §1061, sub-§5 is enacted to 25 read: 26 5. Sale on Sunday. A hotel may sell liquor on 27 Sunday beginning at 10 a.m. in conjunction with the 28 sale of food.' 29 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 30 88 the following: 'Sec. 89. 28-A MRSA §1063, sub-§5 is enacted to 31 32 read: 5.
