HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 1348, L.D. 1842,
Bill, "AN ACT to Make Substantive Changes in the Li-
quor Laws."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 13 the
following:

'Sec. 14. 28-A MRSA §4, sub-§1, 1A, as enacted
by PL 1987, c. 45, §4, is repealed and the following
enacted in its place:

A. Except as provided in subparagraph (1), li-
censees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the
hours of 6 a.m. and 12 noon.

(1) Hotel and Class A restaurants may sell
liquor on Sundays beginning at 10 a.m. in
accordance with sections 1061 and 1063 re-
spectively.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section
84 the following:

'Sec. 85. 28-A MRSA §1061, sub-§5 is enacted to
read:

5. Sale on Sunday. A hotel may sell liquor on
Sunday beginning at 10 a.m. in conjunction with the
sale of food.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section
88 the following:

'Sec. 89. 28-A MRSA §1063, sub-§5 is enacted to
read:

5. Sale on Sunday. A Class A restaurant may

1 sell liquor on Sunday beginning at 10 a.m. in con-
2 junction with the sale of food.'

3 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
4 tions to read consecutively.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This amendment allows Class A restaurant and ho-
7 tels holding liquor licenses to sell liquor on Sun-
8 days starting at 10 a.m. This will allow these li-
9 censees to serve liquor with their Sunday brunches.
10 The liquor must be sold in conjunction with the sale
11 of food.
