SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1348, L.D. 1842,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Make Substantive Changes in the Li-  
quor Laws."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 23 the  
following:

'Sec. 24. 28-A MRSA §601, sub-§2, ¶F, as enacted  
by PL 1987, c. 45, §4, is amended to read:


F. A full-time law enforcement officer benefits  
financially either directly or indirectly;'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-  
tions to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows part-time, but not full-  
time, law enforcement officers to hold liquor li-  
censes.
