**AN ACT to Authorize the State Bureau of
Identification to Charge Fees to
Nongovernmental Agencies for Services.**

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5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 25 MRSA §1541, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

8 6. Criminal History Record Computer Account. The
9 State Bureau of Identification may charge nongovern-
10 mental organizations for services provided pursuant
11 to this chapter. The commissioner shall establish a
12 schedule of fees which shall cover the cost of pro-
13 viding these services, 25% of which shall be credited
14 to the General Fund and 75% of which shall be cred-
15 ited to the Highway Fund.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill provides that revenue collected from nongovernmental organizations shall be apportioned as follows: 25% shall go to the General Fund and 75% shall go to the Highway Fund.

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
