SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 632, L.D. 1853,
"Resolve, Establishing the Maine Commission of Forest
Land Taxation."

Amend the resolve by inserting after the title
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
and

Whereas, recent changes in federal tax policies,
economic conditions and international competition
have raised questions about the relationship between
the State's tax policies with regard to forest land;
and

Whereas, this relationship needs careful and im-
mediate study in order to provide recommendations to
the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature;
and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Further amend the resolve by adding at the end
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. This resolve shall take effect
when approved.'
