1 AN ACT to Clarify the Authority of  
2 Municipalities to Construct Sewer  
3 Systems or Sewage Disposal Systems.  
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
6 follows:

7 30 MRSA §4352, first ¶ is amended to read:

8 The municipal officers of a town or a committee  
9 duly chosen by the town may, at the expense of the  
10 town, construct public drains or sewers, sewer sys-  
11 tems or sewage disposal systems along or across any  
12 public way therein and through or upon any lands of  
13 persons or corporations when they deem it necessary  
14 for public convenience or health. Neither the municipi-  
15 pal officers of the town nor such committee shall

1 construct any public sewer, sewer system or sewage  
2 disposal system therein until the same shall be au-  
3 thorized by vote of said town and an appropriation  
4 made for the purpose, and when constructed, such sew-  
5 ers, sewer systems or sewage disposal systems shall  
6 be under the control of the municipal officers.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to clarify the au-  
9 thority of a municipality to construct sewer systems  
10 and sewage disposal systems.

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
