Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 .follows: 30 MRSA \$4352, first ¶ is amended to read: 7 8 municipal officers of a town or a committee 9 duly chosen by the town may, at the expense of :10 town, construct public drains or sewers, sewer sys-11 tems or sewage disposal systems along or across 12 public way therein and through or upon any lands of persons or corporations when they deem it necessary for public convenience or health. Neither the munici-13 14 15 pal officers of the town nor such committee shall
