SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 639, L.D. 1865, Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Maine Low-level Radioac-8 9 tive Waste Authority."

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part desig-10 nated "§1512." in subsection 1, paragraph A, in the 11 6th line (page 9, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out 12 the following: "to confirmation" and inserting in 13 its place the following: 'to review by the joint 14 15 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and natural resources and 16 17 confirmation

Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part 18 designated "<u>§1512.</u>" in subsection 1, paragraph B, in 19 the 2nd line from the end (page 9, line 32 in L.D) by 20 inserting after the following: "subject to" the fol-21 lowing: 'review by the joint standing committee of 22 23 the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and 24 natural resources and'

25 Further amend the bill in section 4 in that part 26 designated "§1523." in subsection 3 in the last line (page 15, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the fol-27 "July" and inserting in its place the fol-28 lowing: 29 lowing: 'October'

30 Further amend the bill in section 5 in the next 31 to the last line (page 23, line 40 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "fiscal year 1986-87 and" 32

33 Further amend the bill in section 6 under the caption "ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, DEPARTMENT OF" by 34 striking out the first 5 lines (page 24, lines 21 to 35 36 25 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the follow-37 ing:

7 Further amend the bill by striking out all of the 8 fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This new draft will increase dedicated revenue in 10 11 Radioactive Waste Evaluation Fund of up to the 12 \$300,000 in 1987. Those funds are allocated in fiscal year 1987-88. There will be an increase in dedi-cated revenue of \$100,000 beginning in fiscal year 13 14 1988-89 in that fund due to the increase proposed in 15 the cap from \$150,000 to \$250,000. Included in this 16 17 bill is an allocation to the Department of Environmental Protection - Technical Studies of \$31,000 for 18 19 fiscal year 1988-89.

20 In addition, this new draft creates a Low-level 21 Radioactive Waste Facility Fund to pay for the admin-22 istrative and operational costs of the authority and 23 the planning, siting, construction, operation and 24 maintenance, closure and post-closure costs of a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility. 25 The money in that fund is to be raised by assessments on 26 nuclear power plants operating in the State and other 27 generators of low-level radioactive waste in the State and by imposition of fees on users of the fa-28 29 30 The assessment for planning, siting and concility. 31 struction of the facility is limited to \$10,000,000.

32 Finally, this new draft results in a possible fu-33 ture cost to the General Fund due to the provision

which could make the State liable for damages resulting from disposal activities.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment makes technical changes in the 5 bill to clarify the confirmation process for members 6 of the Maine Low-level Radioactive Waste Authority, 7 changes a date for rulemaking, deletes reference to 8 fiscal year 1986-87 and adds a line for capital ex-9 penditures in the allocation. This ammendment also 10 puts a corrected fiscal note on the bill.
