5 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
6 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;

8                      Whereas, York County has certain expenses and li-  
9 abilities which must be met as they become due; and

10                     Whereas, this legislation must be enacted as an  
11 emergency measure as York County has already begun  
12 its fiscal year and adjustments must be made immedi-  
13 ately to the county budget; and
