5 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
6 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
7 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8 Whereas, a recent interpretation made by the
9 Board of Social Worker Registration could jeopardize
10 the employment status of several hundred state em-
11 ployees and cause a substantial increase in costs to
12 several state agencies; and

13 Whereas, such costs are not included in the
14 1987-89 biennial budgets; and
