1 **AN ACT to Reallocate Certain Funds in the**
2 **Aroostook County Unorganized Territory**
3 **Budget for Services to be Rendered in**
4 **Fiscal Year 1987-88.**

6 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
7 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
8 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

9 Whereas, prompt determination and certification
10 of the amended unorganized territory budget of
11 Aroostook County be implemented for fiscal year
12 1987-88; and

13 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
14 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 **Sec. 1. Allocations.** Allocations to the
8 Aroostook County unorganized territory budget submit-
9 ted for services rendered in fiscal year 1987-88 are
10 as follows:

11 1987-88

12 Fire protection and
13 ambulance for other
14 territories (\$1,000)

15 T8-R4 (Masadis)	
16 Fire Protection	1,000
17 T12-R8 (Ashland)	
18 Ambulance Service	3,000
19 T14-R7 (Eagle Lake)	
20 Ambulance Service	889

21 **Sec. 2. Additional funds.** The additional funds
22 of \$3,889 will be funded from the Unorganized Terri-
23 tory Educational and Services Fund's undesignated
24 fund balance. The State Tax Assessor is authorized to
25 expend this amount along with the regular municipal
26 cost component quarterly payment.

27 The effect of this change negates a change in the
28 tax assessment.

29 **Sec. 3. Unorganized Territory Education and Ser-**
30 **vices Fund.** The allocation from the Unorganized Ter-
31 ritory Education and Services Fund as authorized un-
32 der this Act and previously authorized under Private
33 and Special Law 1987, chapter 53, for all services
34 for the county, shall be paid on a quarterly basis.
35 The funds for ambulance service to be paid for by
36 those townships serviced by Ambulance Services, Inc.,
37 shall be paid to the corporation based on the state
38 valuation as determined by Ambulance Services, Inc.,

1 a nonprofit corporation with offices in Fort Kent,
2 Maine.

3 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited
4 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
5 proved.

6 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

7 The changes in the Aroostook County unorganized
8 territory budget reallocates the fire protection and
9 ambulance services to specific townships.

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
