STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend a Section of the Motor Vehicle Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA \$1111, last %, as amended by PL 1987, c. 499, §2, is further amended to read:

Removal of any part or accessory,-or-any-item-located-in-the-interior-or-trunk--compartment of such vehicle while it is in the possession or on the premises of such garage, parking lot or service station, without the express written permission of the owner or manager of such garage, parking lot or service station shall be considered a misdemeanor and the person doing the removing of such part or acces-

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sory shall be liable to prosecution. This shall apply to removal without written permission of the vehicle itself, and shall include any person or persons whatsoever, including the owner of the vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The bill repeals the prohibition against owners 7 of a towed vehicle from removing their personal 8 posessions from the vehicle. This prohibition was 9 inadvertently enacted earlier in the session in L.D. 10 1590.

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
