Vehicle Law.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 29 MRSA §1111, last ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c.
7 499, §2, is further amended to read:

8 Removal of any part or accessory, ~~or any item lo-~~
9 ~~cated in the interior or trunk compartment~~ of such
10 vehicle while it is in the possession or on the
11 premises of such garage, parking lot or service sta-
12 tion, without the express written permission of the
13 owner or manager of such garage, parking lot or ser-
14 vice station shall be considered a misdemeanor and
15 the person doing the removing of such part or acces-

1 sory shall be liable to prosecution. This shall ap-
2 ply to removal without written permission of the ve-
3 hicle itself, and shall include any person or persons
4 whatsoever, including the owner of the vehicle.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The bill repeals the prohibition against owners
7 of a towed vehicle from removing their personal
8 possessions from the vehicle. This prohibition was
9 inadvertently enacted earlier in the session in L.D.
10 1590.
