Amend the bill by striking out all of the emer-gency preamble.

Further amend the bill after the enacting clause in the 4th line (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "15" and inserting in its place the following: '16'

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and clause from the bill and raises the age at which vic-tims of sexual abuse are allowed to testify outside of open court from 15 to 16.
