STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize Aroostook County to Raise \$500,000 for Renovations and Additions to the Aroostook County Jail.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, funds were raised by Aroostook County pursuant to Private and Special Law 1985, chapter 55, to make renovations and additions to the Aroostook County Jail; and

12 Whereas, projected costs of the project require 13 that the county be authorized to raise an additional 14 \$500,000; and

1 Whereas, it is necessary that such authorization 2 take effect immediately in order that the completion 3 date of the project, April of 1988, be met; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

10 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 11 follows:

12 Sec. 1. To raise money for new detention facili-13 ty. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Ti-14 tle 30, section 404, the county commissioners of 15 Aroostook County are authorized to raise and expend a 16 sum not exceeding \$500,000 to make renovations and 17 additions to the Aroostook County jail.

18 Sec. 2. Aid from other sources. The county com-19 missioners of Aroostook County are authorized to bor-20 row any portion of the sums authorized in this Act 21 from or through any agency or department of this 22 State and of the Federal Government. The county com-23 missioners are authorized to receive grants of money and other assistance from or through any agency or department of the State and of the Federal Government 24 25 26 for any of the purposes authorized in this Act.

Bonds. 27 Sec. 3. To provide funds for the and additions to the jail, the Aroostook 28 renovations 29 County treasurer, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow from time to time upon the 30 full faith and credit of the county such sums not ex-31 32 ceeding in the aggregate \$500,000, as may be neces-33 and may issue self-liquidating bonds for the sary, 34 purpose which shall bear on their face the words 35 County Capital Improvement Bonds Act of "Aroostook 36 1987." Each authorized issue shall be payable in such annual installments, beginning not more than 2 37 years from the date of issue and not earlier than the 38 year 1989, as will extinguish each loan in not more 39 40 than 20 years from its date. The bonds shall be 41 signed by the county treasurer and countersigned by

the majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell these securities at public or private sale upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but at not less than par and accrued interest.

Sec. 4. Temporary notes. The county treasurer, with the approval of the county commissioners, may issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not more than one year from their dates, in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds under this Act and may renew the same, but the time within which these serial bonds shall become due and payable shall not, by reason of these temporary notes, be extended beyond the term fixed by this Act. Any notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds shall be paid from the proceeds of the issue.

17 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 18 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-19 proved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes Aroostook County to raise the sum of \$500,000 in order to successfully complete the renovations and additions to the county jail which were begun with funds acquired pursuant to Private and Special Law 1985, chapter 55.
