STATEMENT OF FACT

Public Law 1987, chapter 343, repealed the exemption for Maine State Lottery winnings from the state income tax effective July 1, 1987. The simultaneous recodification of the lottery law effective September 29, 1987, failed to recognize the repeal of the exemption and reenacted the exemption. Consequently, it is necessary to again repeal the income tax exemption in order to preserve the fiscal adjustments already incorporated into the fiscal year 1988-89 budgets and to generally resolve the conflict.
