7 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
8 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
9 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

10 Whereas, the Judicial Department needs certain
11 employees for the proper operation of the courts
12 whose employment with the department will be termi-
13 nated unless permanent positions are authorized and
14 funded; and

1 to the same system as that used by the Executive and
2 Legislative Departments, permanent positions must be
3 authorized and funded by the Legislature or these em-
4 ployees will be terminated, resulting in delay and
5 denial of speedy justice to which the citizens of
6 Maine are entitled.

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
