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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1400, L.D.
1899, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Stored Lobsters."

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Amend the bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and before the emergency clause
and inserting in its place the following:

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'12 MRSA §6431, sub-§6-A is enacted to read:

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6-A. Grace period. There is a 180-day grace pe-
riod following the effective date of each of the min-
imum size increases as provided in this section with-
in which a person holding a wholesale or retail
seafood dealer license or a lobster transportation
license may handle lobsters legally purchased or re-
ceived in the prior year which do not meet the new
minimum size requirements.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment restricts application of the grace
period to persons holding a wholesale or retail deal-
ers license or a lobster transportation license. It
also rewords the original bill to clarify its intent.

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
