The plan shall guide the State's activities in disposing of the State's low-level radioactive waste. The plan shall be adopted by December-1,-1987 January 1, 1988, and shall be updated annually. The first plan is intended to meet the January 1, 1988, milestone date for the development of a siting plan required by the United States Code, Title 42, Section 5(e)(1)(B), of the United States Low-level Radioactive Policy Amendments Act of 1985, Public Law 99-240.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
