8 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
9 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
10 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

11 Whereas, Public Law 1987, chapter 195, required
12 the Department of Educational and Cultural Services
13 to approve long-term care facilities' educational
14 programs for certified nursing assistants if the ex-
15 isting educational delivery system could not provide
16 those programs; and
