Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the study committee cannot complete its work by the reporting deadline established pursuant to Resolves 1987, chapter 71; and

Whereas, the 90-day period will run beyond that reporting deadline; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

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Resolves 1987, c. 71, sub-§2 is amended to read:

2. Scope of study; report. The study will encompass program regulations, program operations, systems for program monitoring and oversight and any other aspects of the program deemed appropriate by the committee.

13 The committee shall submit a report to the Joint 14 Standing Committee on Audit and Program Review 15 the Division of Community Services, by October-317 1987 February 1, 1988, unless the Legislative Council authorizes a later date for submission of the report. 16 17 18 The report shall contain the committee's recommendafor ensuring that all available resources are 19 20 effectively and efficiently utilized to provide 21 weatherization services, that equitable levels of 22 service are provided throughout the State and 23 consistent uniform standards are used to monitor 24 quality of services.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to change the reporting deadline of the Weatherization Services Study Committee from October 31, 1987, to February 1, 1988.
