4 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
5 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
6 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

8 Prince Edward Island; and

10 concerned that this infestation may spread to their  
11 potato fields and damage their crops; and
