The purpose of this bill is to limit an expansion of the pool of numbers in the "Tri-State Lottery."

4 Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont have entered in-5 compact for the purpose of conducting the 6 "Tri-State Megabucks" game. The Lottery Commission 7 has decided to increase the pool of numbers in the 8 Megabucks game from 36 numbers to 40 numbers. 9 rently, in order to win, an individual must successfully pick 6 of the 36 numbers. Under the new pro-10 posal, an individual would have to successfully pick 11 12 6 of 40 numbers. This increase will approximately 13 double an individual's odds against winning.

The increase in the pool of numbers has led to public disillusionment with the Maine State Lottery and threatens to undermine public support of a heretofore successful program.

18 This bill will require that the pool of numbers 19 in the Tri-State Megabucks game remains at 36.
