4 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
5 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
6 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

7 Whereas, starting on January 1, 1988, every oper-  
8 ator or owner of a motor vehicle must present evi-  
9 dence of motor vehicle liability insurance or finan-  
10 cial responsibility in the form of an insurance iden-  
11 tification card; and

12 Whereas, the new compulsory insurance law failed  
13 to recognize the self-insured status of all govern-  
14 ment-owned vehicles and provide exemption to the evi-  
15 dence of insurance provisions; and
