HOUSE AMENDMENT """ to S.P. 701, L.D. 1926,
"Resolve, to Continue the Commission to Study the Integration of the Maine State Retirement System with
the United States Social Security System."

11 Amend the resolve by inserting after the title 12 the following:

13 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves 14 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 15 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; 16 and

17 Whereas, during the First Regular Session of the 18 113th Legislature, the commission to study the inte-19 gration of the Maine State Retirement System and the 20 United States Social Security System was asked to re-21 port to the Governor and the Legislature no later 22 than December 1, 1987; and

23 Whereas, the commission has found it does not 24 have sufficient time to complete this report; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

31 Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end 32 before the statement of fact the following:

33 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 34 cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect 35 when approved.'
