7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 702, L.D. 1927, 8 "Resolve, to Extend the Interim Reporting Deadline of 9 the Maine Commission to Review Overcrowding at the 10 Augusta Mental Health Institute and the Bangor Mental 11 Health Institute."

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12 Amend the resolve by inserting after the title 13 the following:

14 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves 15 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 16 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; 17 and

18 Whereas, during the First Regular Session of the 19 113th Legislature the Maine Commission to Review 20 overcrowding at the Augusta Mental Health Institute 21 and the Bangor Mental Health Institute was asked to 22 report to the legislature no later than December 1, 23 1987; and

24 Whereas, the commission has found it does not 25 have sufficient time to complete this report; and

26 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 27 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 28 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 29 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-30 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 31 therefore, be it'

32 Further amend the resolve by inserting before the 33 Statement of Fact the following:

34 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 35 cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect 36 when approved.' HOUSE AMENDMENT " to S.P. 702, L.D. 1927
