HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 702, L.D. 1927,
"Resolve, to Extend the Interim Reporting Deadline of
the Maine Commission to Review Overcrowding at the
Augusta Mental Health Institute and the Bangor Mental
Health Institute."

Amend the resolve by inserting after the title
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves
of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
and

Whereas, during the First Regular Session of the
113th Legislature the Maine Commission to Review
overcrowding at the Augusta Mental Health Institute
and the Bangor Mental Health Institute was asked to
report to the legislature no later than December 1,
1987; and

Whereas, the commission has found it does not
have sufficient time to complete this report; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, be it'

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect
when approved.'
